



# 2008 COLUMBIA VALLEY WHITE RIESLING

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## GRAPES

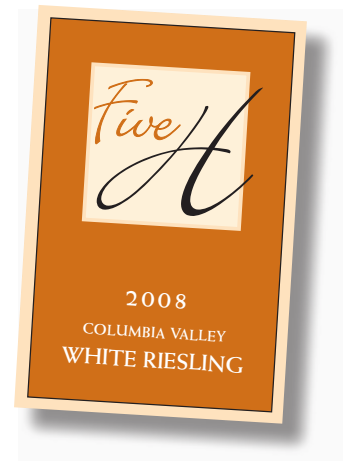
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As the second vintage of the Five H White Riesling, the grapes for our 2008 wine were harvested from a different vineyard than the 2006 offering. These grapes were grown much closer to the Columbia River, near the town of Mattawa, Wash., the main differences between this and our previously released wine is the soil type, which produces a slightly different flavor. The grapes were harvested on October 30, 2008. Grape acid levels were lower in 2008 than 2006, but the fruit character was exceptional, and will reward us with another great wine offering from the Columbia Valley.

## WINE

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Our 2008 Columbia Valley Five H White Riesling expresses zesty and fresh fruit, offering a vibrant style that is consistent with our wines. The 2008 vintage will not need as much sussreserve, which balances the acid in the finished wine. The wine will still, however, offer the richness and depth that we demand with Five H White Riesling. As Always, the wine will evolve over time in its "marriage" with sussreserve. The wine was fermented cool to retain all the delicate aromatics that white riesling demonstrates.
