



2009 COLUMBIA VALLEY WHITE RIESLING

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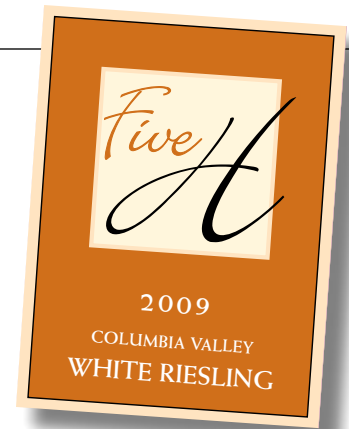
GRAPES

With grapes harvested from vineyards close to the Columbia River near Mattawa, Washington, the 2009 Five H White Riesling reflects soil and vineyard exposure differences. This allows each vintage to show individual "personality" from the selected vineyard we use.

Five H has worked with white riesling from this region for three vintages, and it's apparent the Columbia Valley is rich with fine grape growing areas perfect for Five H's style of wines.

WINE

This 2009 Five H Columbia Valley White Riesling was fermented cool, which helped generate an inspirational aroma, which makes the wine enjoyable before it even reaches your taste buds. The wine depicts floral fruits, and various spring and summer thoughts. It's acidity is balanced by sweetness, offering a richness and depth characteristic of Five H's White Riesling wine.



This is the first vintage of the Five H White Riesling to include the International Riesling Foundation scale for sweetness on our label. The scale is used worldwide to help consumers better understand what style of riesling they are purchasing.
